Further Instructions for Managers on



Staff Screening

*<u>For employees, agency staff, contract staff ONLY</u>: If the person has answered NO to questions 2, 3, or 4, BUT yes to question 1 (symptoms), a manager can clarify question 1 before determining if the employee can continue to work or be sent home.

- Fever If a person self-reports a fever, they should go home until 24 hours after fever has resolved without using any antipyretics (i.e. Advil, Tylenol)
- Cough Clarify if this is a <u>new onset of cough</u> or <u>worsening of pre-existing or</u> <u>chronic cough.</u>

If yes \rightarrow staff to be sent home.

If no \rightarrow Identify:

- 1. If source of cough can be identified by staff (i.e. medication, smokers cough, etc.) they can continue to work.
- 2. If source of cough cannot be identified by staff, they should be sent home and advised to see their healthcare provider or call Telehealth Ontario.
- Difficulty breathing → Staff to be sent home and advised to see their healthcare provider or call Telehealth Ontario
