## 1. Updates and Recommendations to/from MCCSS:

Messages and Response from Laura Summers and Christine Kuepfer

- Laura and Christine provided feedback on yesterday's takeaways and have committed to attend the PN/OASIS/CLO daily information sharing calls
- Discussion regarding importance of managing expectations and empowering people to work with their regional offices/Program Supervisors, local planning tables, and health units to create responses that incorporate their individual community/agency needs
- Confirmation of DS representation at EOC tables and commitments/clarification on how we can assure that there is fluid conversation between community and up to and back from MEOC and PEOC tables.
- Noted that information gathered through Regional Offices and committees such as PN is consistently fed to the EOC representative. Outcomes of these conversations will be shared out through regional offices in a consistent messaging and to this table as appropriate
- 2. Issues/ Risks: To Be Summarized and Presented by meeting Participants
  - PPE -shortages and difficulty accessing
  - Family visits and taking the individuals out of supported homes -is this a service disruption?
  - How to manage cascading and escalating health/staffing challenges upon confirmed CODIV-19
    - o From an employee perspective and from a service recipient perspective

- 3. **Significant Decisions**: Based on Recommendations from Take-Aways & Today's Conversations
  - Michelle to draft correspondence from the Provincial Groups to help manage expectations and direct service providers to resources and recommended communication and planning at the local level
  - Commitment to gather information from this group on 'cascading scenarios' pertaining to the
    various stages of the COVID-19 virus and what agencies should be implementing. Members

    forward.
