- 455 new cases were reported in Ontario today, bringing the cumulative case count to 30,202 (this includes 23,947 resolved cases and 2,407 deaths).
- In Ontario, a total of 832,158 tests have been completed, with tests performed at Public Health Ontario Laboratories and non-Public Health Laboratories. There are currently 12,384 tests under investigation.
- 673 patients are currently hospitalized with COVID-19; 117 are in ICU; and 97 are in ICU on a ventilator.

Actions Taken:

 The Ontario government, after consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health, has <u>extended</u> all emergency orders currently in force under s.7.0.2 (4) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act until June 19, 2020.
